Our Cabaña (Mexico)

Volunteers come to Our Cabaña for a period of between six and nine weeks depending on our different seasons. The positions encompass all the duties required to help run a successful event or seminar and also maintain the house to a high standard. This role gives everyone the opportunity to assist in all aspects of volunteering at our World Centre.



Summer Season:

June to September – 12 positions available

Winter Season:

Mid October to mid December – four positions available

January to mid April- ten positions available

At Our Cabaña you can become one of our long term volunteer Program assistants who are with us for six months: May – October and November – April.

The Program assistant helps with the preparations for international events, as well as the running of events. It's a great opportunity to experience life abroad, develop training skills, enjoy the friendship and fun of international Girl Guiding/ Girl Scouting, learn Spanish as a new language and explore and travel around Mexico.

Our Chalet (Switzerland)

Sangam (India)

Programme assistants

At Sangam you can become a Programme assistant:

Three month or six month terms: June – September or October – March.

Programme assistants run general event sessions such as Indian arts & crafts, sari tying, visits to community organizations, campfire, sightseeing around Pune, visiting an Indian home and International evenings. Depending on their skill level and interests, volunteers are encouraged and supported to develop and deliver theme specific sessions based on global issues and WAGGGS initiatives.

Assistant programme manager

The Assistant programme manager runs event sessions alongside the Programme assistants. In addition, she helps the Programme manager with event planning, publicity, and administration.

The Assistant programme manager works from June to March.
